OUR ISLAND, OUR LIVES is a 2-week campaign co-produced by the Office of the Governor, PBS Guam and the Guam Coastal Management Program, Bureau of Statistics and Plans to (1) push out information on to how effectively respond to the Draft Environmental Impact Statement and (2) collect comments on the DEIS for submission by the People of Guam to the Department of Defense in written form in order to effect the most impactful reaction by the Department of Defense to local concerns.

The campaign features a series of educational and comment collection events that target the general population and high school students. These events are as follows:
