

NAVAL GOVERNMENT OF GUAM

Executive Order Number 4-46.

TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.

Paragraph 3 of Chapter XXXII of the Civil Regulations with the Force and Effect of Law in Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No picture, either still or cinema, shall be taken, developed, or printed of any military installation or panoramic views of the Island of Guam or its coast lines. Photographs taken shall in general be confined to views of individuals and to non-military scenic views. Pictures of individuals and non-military scenic views shall not contain backgrounds of the herein stated prohibited objects. Violators of this paragraph shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or imprisonment for not less than one month nor more than one year or both.
