

NAVAL GOVERNMENT OF GUAM

Executive Order Number 4-47

TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM

Section B of Section 1 of Chapter XVIII of The Civil Regulations With The Force And Effect Of Law In Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) The Board of Education shall be composed of seven members as follows:

- (a) One member from the House of Council of the Guam Congress to be selected by the Guam Congress.
- (b) One representative from the House of Assembly of the Guam Congress to be selected by the Guam Congress.
- (c) Three representatives to be selected at large by the citizens of Guam at the regular general election for members of Congress.
- (d) Two representatives to be appointed by the Governor from the Armed Forces of the United States of America in Guam.
- (e) The Head of the Department of Education and the Superintendent of Schools shall be Ex Officio members, but shall have no voting powers.
- (f) The Governor of Guam shall fill any vacancy on this Board by appointment to hold office until such vacancy is filled in the manner hereinbefore stated.

"(2) Members shall serve for a term of three years.


"(3) The Chairman shall be elected by the seven voting members on the first meeting of the Board from among the members of the Board, and shall serve as Chairman for a term of one year at which time a new Chairman shall be selected in the same manner.

"(4) The Board of Education shall meet at least once each month and the date, time and place shall be as determined by the Board."
