

First 2009 Guam Phone Book Given to Governor

Yellow Pages Ink launches two new products leading to 20th anniversary edition

Yellow Pages Ink this morning presented the first copy of the 2009 Guam Phone Book to Governor Felix P. Camacho. This is the 20th anniversary edition of the Guam Phone Book.
