

Public Invited to Compatibility Sustainability Study Workshop

The Governor's Office announced today that the Advisory Consulting Team (ACT) will be conducting the second round of public workshops pertaining to the Compatibility Sustainability Study (CSS) they have been conducting on behalf of the governor's office. The primary goal of the CSS is to reduce potential conflicts between military missions and the Guam community, while sustaining the island's economic vitality, accommodating targeted job development, and protecting the public's health and safety.
